And in another hadīth recorded by al-Bukhārī and Muslim:

They (the people of Paradise) will have no differences or disagreements between themselves, and there will not be any hatred between them. Their hearts will be like a single heart. And they will glorify Allah in the morning and afternoon.

The person will then ask, "Are you making fun of me?" or "Are you laughing at me while you are the King?"
